

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord



There are several different ceremonies that the Jewish families participated in soon after the birth of a baby. The first one was Circumcision for a boy of eight days old. This symbolized the Jews separation from the Gentiles and the special relationship they had with God. The second ceremony was Redemption of the firstborn son. This showed that the parents acknowledged that their son was from God and that He had the power to give life.

The last ceremony was that of Purification of the mother. After giving birth to a child, a mother was said to be unclean and was not able to go to the temple for 40 days after the birth of a son and 80 days after the birth of a daughter. Once this time of purification was over, the parents were to take an offering to the priest at the temple. If the parents could afford a lamb, it was given as a sacrifice, if they couldn't afford a lamb, two doves could be given as a sacrifice. Mary and Joseph gave two doves, which would signify that they didn't have very much money.

Thus, the presentation of Jesus in the temple served two purposes; the first is the redemption of the first-born and the second is the purification of Mary. Of course Our Lady did not need this purification because she was a virgin before, during and after the birth of Jesus but she did it so that the Law might be fulfilled. It is also to say that Jesus did not come to abolish the Lord, but fulfill it. May the Spirit of God strengthen us so that we may be able to follow the footsteps of the Nazareth's family.

Fiesta de la Presentación del Señor

Hay varias ceremonias diferentes en las que participaban las familias judías poco después del nacimiento de un bebé. La primera era la circuncisión de un niño de ocho días. Esto simbolizaba la separación de los judíos de los gentiles y la relación especial que tenían con Dios. La segunda ceremonia era la redención del hijo primogénito. Esto mostraba que los padres reconocían que su hijo era de Dios y que Él tenía el poder de dar vida. La última ceremonia era la de la purificación de la madre.

Después de dar a luz a un niño, se decía que la madre era impura y no podía ir al templo durante 40 días después del nacimiento de un hijo y 80 días después del nacimiento de una hija. Una vez que este tiempo de purificación terminaba, los padres debían llevar una ofrenda al sacerdote en el templo. Si los padres podían permitirse un cordero, se lo daban como sacrificio, si no podían permitirse un cordero, se podían dar dos palomas como sacrificio. María y José dieron dos palomas, lo que significaría que no tenían mucho dinero.

Así, la presentación de Jesús en el templo tenía dos finalidades: la primera es la redención del primogénito y la segunda es la purificación de María. Por supuesto que Nuestra Señora no necesitaba esta purificación porque era virgen antes, durante y después del nacimiento de Jesús, pero lo hizo para que se cumpliera la Ley. Es decir, Jesús no vino a abolir al Señor, sino a cumplirlo. Que el Espíritu de Dios nos fortalezca para que podamos seguir los pasos de la familia de Nazaret.

Question:

Presentation of the Lord

Luke's Gospel is the only one to mention the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple. What is Luke trying to communicate here and what connection does it have with Mary?

Answer:

February 2 is exactly forty days after December 25, the nativity of Jesus. Jewish law (Ex 13:2, 12) dictated that Jesus, as the firstborn, be consecrated to God. This was done by the parents as they presented their Son in the Temple.

Jewish law further specified (Lv 12:2-8) that a mother was ritually impure after giving birth, and that she had to wait a set period of time (forty days for a boy) before she was to offer a sacrifice to the Lord for purification.

The convergence of these two Jewish regulations occasions Luke's account of both the Presentation of the Lord and the Purification of Mary. These days the liturgical emphasis is more on the Presentation of Jesus. Luke highlights the role of Simeon and Anna, two righteous Jews who recognized Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah and praised God for being able to see and experience such a marvel in their lifetimes.

Simeon's prayer concerning the special role of Jesus states that Jesus is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." This phrase eventually originated the custom of blessing candles on this day which were to be used in the ceremonies, rituals, and processions throughout the church year. Thus February 2 is also known as Candlemas Day. This day is indeed a rich feast to be savored. ©LPi
