



### Happy Lent!

In this first Sunday of Lent, the liturgy brings us into the desert with Jesus to reflect on his temptations. Why Jesus would allow himself to be tempted. First, he is a human; every human is subjected to temptations. So is Jesus. Second, Jesus allowed the temptations so as to set up for us a good example, and to teach us how to overcome the temptations that we may experience in our lives.

There are three different temptations Jesus underwent. It is often called triple A's temptations: Appetite, Ambition & Arrogance. These three temptations are also our temptations. The devil invites us to turn towards self. Jesus invites us to turn towards God. It is also important to realize that all temptations come to us under the guise of some kind of goodness. That is how devil traps us. He could appear in the form of a well-dressed man with pleasing personality who sweet-talks to you to cheat on your husband. The devil could also be in a form of a charming lady who seduces you to be unfaithful to your wife. Devil is dangerous.

What should we do to overcome his temptations? **The** catechism says that we must avoid the occasions of sin at all times. Occasions of sin are persons, places, or things that can easily lead us into sin. If you have drinking problem, don't drive by the liquor stores. If you are on diet, don't watch cooking program. Somebody wrote: *"To pray against temptation but not to avoid the occasion of sin is like putting your hand in the fire and pray that the hand does not get burned."* The best way to stop it is when it begins. The trouble starts when we entertain the idea, running it over in our minds. We permit our imagination to wander uncontrolled, it takes charge, and our will becomes powerless. Like Christ, we must say NO early right from the start – "Be gone Satan..."

Like Adam and Eve, and Jesus, we all face temptations. Original sin reminds us that we humans tend to give in to temptation. It is a family trait. Our parents did it and so do we. So, when we are tempted, we should not trust in our own abilities or strength. Instead we should trust in Jesus and his strength. Where humanity fails, Jesus prevails. Let us then during this Lenten season very earnestly pray, as Jesus has taught us to pray to Our Father in heaven – "Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil." Amen!

### ¡Feliz Cuaresma!

En este primer domingo de Cuaresma, la liturgia nos lleva al desierto con Jesús para reflexionar sobre sus tentaciones. Por qué Jesús se dejó tentar. Primero, él es un ser humano; todo ser humano está sujeto a tentaciones. También lo es Jesús. Segundo, Jesús permitió las tentaciones para darnos un buen ejemplo y enseñarnos cómo superar las tentaciones que podamos experimentar en nuestras vidas. Hay tres tentaciones diferentes que experimentó Jesús. A menudo se las llama tentaciones triple A: apetito, ambición y arrogancia. Estas tres tentaciones también son nuestras tentaciones. El diablo nos invita a volvemos hacia nosotros mismos. Jesús nos invita a volvernos hacia Dios. También es importante darnos cuenta de que todas las tentaciones nos llegan bajo la apariencia de algún tipo de bondad. Así es como el diablo nos atrapa. Él podría aparecer en la forma de un hombre bien vestido con una personalidad agradable que te habla dulcemente para que engañes a tu marido. El diablo también podría estar en la forma de una dama encantadora que te seduce para que seas infiel a tu esposa. El diablo es peligroso.

¿Qué debemos hacer para vencer sus tentaciones? El cathecismo dice que debemos evitar las ocasiones de pecado en todo momento. Las ocasiones de pecado son personas, lugares o cosas que fácilmente pueden llevarnos a pecar. Si tienes problemas con la bebida, no pases por las licorerías. Si estás a dieta, no veas programas de cocina. Alguien escribió: "Orar contra la tentación pero no evitar la ocasión de pecar es como poner la mano en el fuego y orar para que la mano no se quemé". La mejor manera de detenerlo es cuando comienza. El problema comienza cuando albergamos la idea, dándole vueltas en nuestra mente. Permitimos que nuestra imaginación vague sin control, toma el control y nuestra voluntad se vuelve impotente. Como Cristo, debemos decir NO desde el principio: "Vete Satanás...". Como Adán y Eva, y Jesús, todos enfrentamos tentaciones. El pecado original nos recuerda que los humanos tendemos a ceder a la tentación. Es un rasgo familiar. Nuestros padres lo hicieron y nosotros también. Entonces, cuando somos tentados, no debemos confiar en nuestras propias habilidades o fuerzas. En cambio, debemos confiar en Jesús y su fuerza. Donde la humanidad falla, Jesús prevalece. Entonces, durante este tiempo de Cuaresma, oremos muy fervientemente, como Jesús nos ha enseñado a orar a Nuestro Padre en el cielo: "No nos dejes caer en la tentación, mas líbranos del mal". ¡Amén!


