Lord, to whom shall we go, you have the words of eternal life

Friends, one of the most challenging aspects of life is commitment. It is commitment that is at the heart of today's readings. Joshua in the first reading proclaims that he and his family will serve the Lord. St. Paul, in the second reading speaks of a commitment of mutual respect and love as the work of husband and wife. And Peter sums it up nicely in the Gospel when he proclaims his commitment of faith and says: "Lord, to whom shall we turn."

A story of a pig and a chicken walking by a church where a gala charity event was taking place. Getting caught up in the spirit, the pig suggested to the chicken that they each make a contribution. "Great idea!" the chicken cried. "Let's offer them ham and eggs?" "Not so fast," said the pig. "For you, that's a contribution. For me, it's a total commitment."

As Christians, we are called to commit ourselves to Christ. Commitment demands a great deal. It demands 100% of ourselves...not 50 or 70%. To commit ourselves is to put other things behind us in order that we might be faithful...faithful to God and to each other. Commitment isn't always easy. But commitment transforms our lives. It is only commitment that opens us to achieving goals and gaining awards that would never be ours without our willingness to commit ourselves. Let us ask our Lord to give us strong faith so we may commit ourselves totally to Him, for "Lord, to whom shall we go, you have the words of eternal life."

Faith Formation Registration for 2024-2025.

Here are the details:

Registration began June 17th and deadline is August 31st.

A Baptism and Birth Certificate are required with your child's registration form.

Classes Offered:

RCIC (Rite of Christian Initiation for Children; Eng. only): Class for children 7 years and older to receive the Sacrament of Baptism at Easter Vigil. The program starts in September and ends in April. It is held on Sunday mornings.

Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th in Parish Hall from 11:00am-12:00pm (after 10am Mass)

RCIA and Adult Confirmation (Eng. & Span. Classes): Class for adults that are interested in receiving Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation. It is held on Monday evenings.

Starting Date: Monday, September 23rd in Office or Parish Hall from 7:00pm-8:30pm.

First Holy Communion: 2 year program, no matter what grade you start. Classes are on Sundays.

Starting Date: Sunday, September 15th. 9-9:50am (Eng.), 1:10-1:50pm(Eng. & Span.), and 2:00-2:50pm (Span. only).

EDGE: Our middle school program to get ready for confirmation program and receive sacraments if needed. Classes are on Wednesday afternoons.

Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in the Parish Hall from 4:30-5:30pm.

Continuing Faith Formation /Post Holy Communion Class: Class to further education after receiving First Communion. It is held on Wednesdays in the afternoon.

Starting Date: Wednesday, September 18th in Parish Hall from 3:00-4:00pm.

Youth Confirmation Program. This is 2 year program. This program is for all high school students who want to receive the sacrament of Confirmation. Classes are on Sundays.

Starting date: Sunday, September 15 in the Parish hall at 11:15am– 12:45pm

Parent Sessions (First Communion and Youth Confirmation Parents): Mandatory Parent Sessions offered once a month in English and Spanish. Classes are held the same time your child/children are in their classes. Parents must attend 5 out of the 7 sessions.




