Baptism of the Lord



Dear Friends,

The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord marks the conclusion of the Christmas Season and the beginning of Ordinary Time. It's a feast of transition from Jesus' hidden life to that of His public ministry.

First of all, it needs to be pointed out that Jesus did not need a baptism, for he was born without a stain of sin. Why did He receive baptism? Jesus did it to show his solidarity with the human race. In lining up for baptism by John like a sinner, Jesus set aside all exemption for himself and completely identified with the sinful humanity and became one like us. The Jews came to John for Baptism, so did Jesus. The Jews paid taxes to Caesar, so did Jesus. Second, it has been said that when Jesus entered the waters of baptism, he was not baptized by the waters, rather, his baptism was one in which all the created waters of this world were, in a sense, "baptized" by Him. By entering into the waters, Jesus sanctified water and poured forth His grace making all water the future source of salvation. Third, the Baptism of Jesus was an epiphany. It was a moment of manifestation. His baptism is a way in which the Father introduced His Son and His Son's mission to the world.

In short, the baptism of the Lord gives us a taste of God's unconditional love for all of us. God is not waiting for us to come to him, but he comes to us. He steps into the Jordan to absorb the sin into himself and to set us free. As we prepare to begin Ordinary Time, let's reflect upon these words of the Father: "You are my beloved Son; with you I am well pleased." Let's turn our eyes to Jesus and heed every word He speaks. He was sent into this world to draw us to the Father, let's allow Him to fulfill that mission in our own life. Amen!

Queridos amigos,

Bautismo del Señor

La fiesta del Bautismo del Señor marca la conclusión del Tiempo de Navidad y el comienzo del Tiempo Ordinario. Es una fiesta de transición de la vida oculta de Jesús a la de su ministerio público.

En primer lugar, es necesario señalar que Jesús no necesitaba un bautismo, porque nació sin mancha de pecado. ¿Por qué recibió el bautismo? Jesús lo hizo para mostrar su solidaridad con la raza humana. Al ponerse en fila para ser bautizado por Juan como un pecador, Jesús dejó de lado toda exención para sí mismo y se identificó completamente con la humanidad pecadora y se hizo uno como nosotros. Los judíos acudieron a Juan para el bautismo, lo mismo hizo Jesús. Los judíos pagaban impuestos al César, lo mismo hizo Jesús. En segundo lugar, se ha dicho que cuando Jesús entró en las aguas del bautismo, no fue bautizado por las aguas, sino que su bautismo fue uno en el que todas las aguas creadas de este mundo fueron, en cierto sentido, "bautizadas" por Él. Al entrar en las aguas, Jesús santificó el agua y derramó su gracia haciendo de toda agua la futura fuente de salvación. En tercer lugar, el Bautismo de Jesús fue una epifanía. Fue un momento de manifestación. Su bautismo es una manera en la que el Padre presentó a Su Hijo y la misión de Su Hijo al mundo.

En resumen, el bautismo del Señor nos da una muestra del amor incondicional de Dios por todos nosotros. Dios no está esperando que vayamos a Él, sino que Él viene a nosotros. Se adentra en el Jordán para absorber el pecado en sí mismo y liberarnos. Mientras nos preparamos para comenzar el Tiempo Ordinario, reflexionemos sobre estas palabras del Padre: "Tú eres mi Hijo amado; en ti tengo complacencia". Dirijamos nuestros ojos a Jesús y prestemos atención a cada palabra que Él dice. Él fue enviado a este mundo para atraernos al Padre, dejémosle cumplir esa misión en nuestra propia vida. ¡Amén!
